A **Boil Water Advisory** has been issued for **ONLY the Homes of Willow Ridge Estates and Brule Road on Bigstone Reserve D Public Water Supply** due to a water main break and potential for system depressurization during maintenance/repairs

Please notify affected community members by the fastest means possible to **bring water to a rolling boil for at least one minute** prior to any consumption, including but not limited to: drinking, making infant formula or juice, brushing teeth, washing fruits and vegetables, or making ice.

Boiling the water will destroy any microorganisms that may be present. Additional information can be found in the document "Using Water Safely During a Boil Water Advisory".
